Azerbaijan Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- **Valid Passport:** Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your planned stay in Azerbaijan and have at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- **Copies of Passport Pages:** Include copies of relevant passport pages, including your personal information page, any previous visas, and entry/exit stamps.
- **Completed Visa Application Form:** Fill out the Azerbaijan visa application form. You can access the form on the "ASAN Visa" e-visa portal.
- **Passport-Sized Photo:** One recent photograph that meets Azerbaijan's photo requirements.
- **Roundtrip Flight Itinerary:** Provide proof of your flight reservations showing your arrival and departure dates, ideally a confirmed booking but at a minimum, a reservation held with the airline.
- **Proof of Accommodation:** This could be a hotel reservation, a letter of invitation from an Azerbaijani resident, or proof of property ownership in Azerbaijan.
- **Travel Medical Insurance:** Your insurance must cover emergency medical expenses while in Azerbaijan.
- **Proof of Sufficient Funds:** Demonstrate that you have the financial means to support yourself during your trip (bank statements, pay stubs, etc.). The minimum requirement is around \$100 per day of your stay.
- **Processing Time:** Start your visa application well in advance, as processing times can vary. It's recommended to apply at least 15 days before your trip, but no more than three months in advance.
- **Visa Fees:** Be prepared to pay the visa application fee, which is non-refundable.
- **Interview:** In rare cases, you may be called for a visa interview at the Azerbaijani embassy or consulate.
- **e-Visa:** Azerbaijan typically issues e-visas (electronic visas). These are single-entry visas valid for stays up to 30 days.
- **Travel to Disputed Territories:** Be aware of potential travel restrictions if you plan to visit disputed territories within Azerbaijan's borders. Always check the latest travel advisories from your government before traveling.
