Iran Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- **Valid Passport:** Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Iran and have at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- **Completed Visa Application Form:** You can find the form online through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iran (MFA) website: https://evisa.mfa.ir/. Fill it out completely and accurately.
- **Two Recent Passport-Sized Photos:** Meeting Iranian photo requirements (white background, clear face, no headscarf required for women).
- **Roundtrip Flight Itinerary:** Provide proof of your flight reservations showing your confirmed arrival and departure dates.
- **Proof of Accommodation:** This could be hotel reservations, a letter of invitation from an Iranian resident along with their ID proof, or proof of property ownership in Iran.
- **Travel Health Insurance:** It's highly recommended to have travel insurance covering medical expenses while in Iran.
- **Proof of Financial Means:** Demonstrate you have sufficient funds to support yourself during your trip (bank statements, pay stubs, etc.). The required amount is not officially stated, but generally demonstrating financial stability is recommended.
- Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate: If traveling from or through a country with a risk of yellow fever transmission, you may need a valid vaccination certificate.
- **Cover Letter:** A detailed letter explaining the purpose of your trip, planned itinerary, and where you will be staying in Iran.
- **Online:** Through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) Electronic Visa System: https://evisa.mfa.ir/
- **In Person:** At the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Islamabad or a Consulate General in Karachi.
- **Processing Time:** Start your visa application well in advance (ideally at least 15 days before your trip), as processing times can vary. However, the online system typically provides faster processing.
- **Visa Fees:** Be prepared to pay the visa application fee, which varies depending on the chosen application method (online or in-person) and the duration of your stay.
- **Interview:** In rare cases, you may be called for a visa interview at the embassy or consulate.
