Iraq Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. **Valid Passport:** Valid for at least six months beyond your intended departure from Iraq and with at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- 2. **Completed Visa Application Form:** Download and fill out the Iraqi visa application form thoroughly and accurately.
- 3. **Two Recent Passport-Sized Photos:** Meeting Iraqi photo specifications (size, background color, etc.).
- 4. **Proof of Travel:** Provide confirmed roundtrip flight reservations or other documentation demonstrating your arrival and departure dates.
- 5. **Proof of Accommodation:** This could be hotel bookings, a letter of invitation from a host in Iraq (including their ID), or proof of property ownership in Iraq.
- 6. **Criminal Records Clearance Certificate:** Obtain a recent police clearance certificate from Pakistan.
- 7. **Proof of Financial Means:** Demonstrate sufficient financial resources to cover your stay in Iraq (bank statements, payslips, etc.). The required amount may vary, so check with the Iraqi embassy or consulate.
- 8. **Travel Health Insurance:** While not mandatory, it's highly recommended to have travel insurance covering medical expenses during your stay in Iraq.
- 9. **Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate:** If traveling from a country with a risk of yellow fever transmission, you may need a valid vaccination certificate.
- 10. **Cover Letter:** A detailed letter explaining the purpose of your visit, planned itinerary, and duration of stay.
- 11.Processing times for Iraqi visas can vary significantly, so it's crucial to apply well in advance of your planned trip, ideally at least 3 months before.
- 12. Visa fees are non-refundable, even if your application is denied.
- 13. You may be required to attend a visa interview at the Iraqi embassy or consulate.
