

Malaysia Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

1. **Valid Passport:** Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Malaysia and have at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
2. **Completed Visa Application Form:** Depending on your application method, this could be an online form (eVisa) or a traditional form you'll need to download and fill out.
3. **Two Recent Passport-Sized Photos:** Ensure the photographs meet Malaysia's specific biometric photo requirements.
4. **Roundtrip Flight Itinerary:** Provide proof of your flight reservations showing your arrival and departure dates, ideally a confirmed booking but at a minimum, a reservation held with the airline.
5. **Proof of Accommodation:** This could be hotel reservations, a letter of invitation from a Malaysian resident, or proof of property ownership in Malaysia.
6. **Proof of Financial Means:** Demonstrate that you have the financial resources to support yourself during your trip (bank statements, pay stubs, etc.). The required amount varies, so it's best to check with a visa agent or consulate.
7. **Processing Time:** Processing times can vary, so it's best to start your application well in advance (at least 15 days before your trip).
8. **Visa Fees:** Be prepared to pay the visa application fee, which is non-refundable.
9. **Additional Requirements:** The Malaysian immigration authorities might request additional documents on a case-by-case basis.
