## Morocco Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. **Valid Passport:** Valid for at least six months beyond your intended stay in Morocco and with at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- 2. **Completed Visa Application Form:** Download, fill out, and sign the application form accurately. Find it on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Morocco (<a href="https://www.consulat.ma/en/ordinary-visas">https://www.consulat.ma/en/ordinary-visas</a>).
- 3. **Two Recent Passport-Sized Photos:** Ensure the photos meet Morocco's specific photo requirements (size, format, background color). Check the specific requirements on the website mentioned above.
- 4. **Original Proof of Onward Travel:** This could be a confirmed flight ticket or other documentation showing your departure from Morocco after your visit.
- 5. **Original or Certified Copies of Previous Passports (if applicable):** If you have used other passports previously, include copies of their relevant pages.
- 6. Hotel Bookings: Confirmed hotel reservations for the duration of your stay in Morocco.
- 7. **Roundtrip Flight Itinerary:** Proof of your booked flights showing your arrival and departure dates.
- 8. **Proof of Financial Means:** Documents demonstrating you have sufficient funds to support yourself during your trip (bank statements, pay slips, etc.). The required amount may vary, so check the official website for the latest information.
- 9. **Travel Health Insurance (Recommended):** While not mandatory, travel insurance covering medical expenses is highly recommended.
- 10.**Cover Letter (Optional):** A detailed letter explaining the purpose of your visit, planned itinerary, and accommodation arrangements.
- 11.**Proof of Employment:** Letter from your employer confirming your employment and leave of absence (if applicable).
- 12.**Proof of Business Ownership (if applicable):** Business registration documents if you are a business owner.
- 13.**Student Enrollment Letter (if applicable):** Proof of your student status if you are a student.
- 14.**Processing Time:** Start your visa application well in advance (ideally at least two months before your trip) due to varying processing times.
- 15. Visa Fees: Be prepared to pay the visa application fee, which is non-refundable.
- 16.**Interview:** In some cases, you may be called for a visa interview at the Moroccan embassy or consulate.
