## Nepal Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. Valid passport: Valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Nepal.
- 2. **Completed visa application form:** Downloadable from the Department of Immigration <a href="https://www.immigration.gov.np/">https://www.immigration.gov.np/</a>.
- 3. **Two recent passport-sized photographs:** As per specifications on the application form.
- 4. **Travel document:** Round-trip flight tickets or other proof of onward travel.
- 5. **Proof of accommodation:** Hotel booking confirmation or invitation letter if staying with someone.
- 6. **Visa Fee:** Payable in USD or Nepalese Rupees (NPR) at the port of entry or online for on-arrival visas <a href="https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/onlinevisa-mission/application">https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/onlinevisa-mission/application</a>.
- 7. **Travel Insurance:** Covering medical emergencies and repatriation costs, with minimum coverage of USD 5,000.
- 8. **Sufficient Funds:** Proof of sufficient funds to cover your stay in Nepal (amount varies based on duration).
- 9. **Vaccination Certificate:** Proof of vaccination against yellow fever, if required for your specific travel history.
- 10. For On-Arrival Visas:
- 11. Completed Arrival Card: Provided on the airplane or upon arrival.
- 12. Visa requirements and procedures can change, so it's recommended to double-check with the **Nepali embassy or consulate** in Pakistan or visit the **Department of Immigration website** <a href="https://www.immigration.gov.np/">https://www.immigration.gov.np/</a> for the latest information.
- 13. Processing times may vary, so apply well in advance of your trip.
- 14. Carry copies of your visa application, travel documents, and confirmation of insurance while traveling in Nepal.
