

Nepal Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

1. **Valid passport:** Valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Nepal.
2. **Completed visa application form:** Downloadable from the Department of Immigration <https://www.immigration.gov.np/>.
3. **Two recent passport-sized photographs:** As per specifications on the application form.
4. **Travel document:** Round-trip flight tickets or other proof of onward travel.
5. **Proof of accommodation:** Hotel booking confirmation or invitation letter if staying with someone.
6. **Visa Fee:** Payable in USD or Nepalese Rupees (NPR) at the port of entry or online for on-arrival visas <https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/onlinevisa-mission/application>.
7. **Travel Insurance:** Covering medical emergencies and repatriation costs, with minimum coverage of USD 5,000.
8. **Sufficient Funds:** Proof of sufficient funds to cover your stay in Nepal (amount varies based on duration).
9. **Vaccination Certificate:** Proof of vaccination against yellow fever, if required for your specific travel history.

11. **Completed Arrival Card:** Provided on the airplane or upon arrival.
12. Visa requirements and procedures can change, so it's recommended to double-check with the **Nepali embassy or consulate** in Pakistan or visit the **Department of Immigration website** <https://www.immigration.gov.np/> for the latest information.
13. Processing times may vary, so apply well in advance of your trip.
14. Carry copies of your visa application, travel documents, and confirmation of insurance while traveling in Nepal.
