Oman Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. **Valid Passport:** Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Oman and have at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- 2. **Completed Online Visa Application Form:** Fill out the form available on the Royal Oman Police website: <u>https://evisa.rop.gov.om/</u>
- 3. **Passport-Sized Photo:** Meeting Omani specifications (white background, clear face, specific dimensions).
- 4. **Proof of Travel:** Roundtrip flight itinerary or booking confirmation.
- 5. **Proof of Accommodation:** Hotel reservation, invitation letter, or proof of property ownership.
- 6. **Proof of Financial Means:** Bank statements, pay stubs, or other documents demonstrating sufficient funds for your stay (check the website for details).
- 7. **Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate:** If arriving from a country with a risk of yellow fever.
- 8. Travel Medical Insurance: While not mandatory, it's highly recommended.
- 9. Visa fee: Varies depending on the visa type and duration of stay. Check the website for current information.
- 10. Processing time: Typically within 24 hours of submitting your application.
- 11.Multiple entry visas are available for stays up to 30 days.
- 12.Visa requirements and regulations can change, so always check the official website for the latest updates: <u>https://evisa.rop.gov.om/</u>
- 13. You may be required to present additional documents upon arrival in Oman.
- 14.You can also apply for a visa on arrival (VOA) at Muscat International Airport, but the eVisa process is generally faster and more convenient.
- 15.GCC residents with a valid resident permit can apply for an eVisa with a simplified process.
