

# Oman Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

1. **Valid Passport:** Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Oman and have at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
2. **Completed Online Visa Application Form:** Fill out the form available on the Royal Oman Police website: <https://evisa.rop.gov.om/>
3. **Passport-Sized Photo:** Meeting Omani specifications (white background, clear face, specific dimensions).
4. **Proof of Travel:** Roundtrip flight itinerary or booking confirmation.
5. **Proof of Accommodation:** Hotel reservation, invitation letter, or proof of property ownership.
6. **Proof of Financial Means:** Bank statements, pay stubs, or other documents demonstrating sufficient funds for your stay (check the website for details).
7. **Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate:** If arriving from a country with a risk of yellow fever.
8. **Travel Medical Insurance:** While not mandatory, it's highly recommended.
9. Visa fee: Varies depending on the visa type and duration of stay. Check the website for current information.
10. Processing time: Typically within 24 hours of submitting your application.
11. Multiple entry visas are available for stays up to 30 days.
12. Visa requirements and regulations can change, so always check the official website for the latest updates: <https://evisa.rop.gov.om/>
13. You may be required to present additional documents upon arrival in Oman.
14. You can also apply for a visa on arrival (VOA) at Muscat International Airport, but the eVisa process is generally faster and more convenient.
15. GCC residents with a valid resident permit can apply for an eVisa with a simplified process.
