

South Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

1. **Valid Passport:** Your passport must have at least 6 months validity remaining from your planned date of departure from South Korea. It should also have blank pages available for visa stamps.
2. **Completed Visa Application Form:** You'll find application forms on the website of the South Korean Embassy in Pakistan or at a designated visa application center.
3. **Passport-Sized Photo:** Your photo must meet South Korea's specific photo requirements.
4. **Roundtrip Flight Itinerary:** Provide proof of your flight reservations showing your arrival and departure dates, ideally confirmed bookings, but at a minimum, reservations held with the airline.
5. **Proof of Accommodation:** This could be a hotel reservation, a letter of invitation from a South Korean resident, or proof of property ownership in South Korea.
6. **Bank Statement:** A recent bank statement demonstrating you have sufficient funds to cover your expenses during your trip to South Korea. The specific amount required can vary, so check with the Embassy for updated information.
7. **Cover Letter:** Explain the purpose of your trip, planned activities, and where you will be staying while in South Korea.
8. **Employment Letter:** A letter from your employer confirming your position, salary, and that your leave has been approved.
9. **Student Certificate:** If you're a student, provide proof of enrollment from your institution.
10. **Invitation Letter:** If you are being invited by a South Korean resident, they will need to provide an invitation letter along with supporting documents.
11. **Itinerary and Travel Plan:** A detailed overview of your planned activities and travel within South Korea.
12. **Processing Time:** Start your visa application well in advance, as processing times can vary.
13. **Visa Fees:** Be prepared to pay the visa application fee, which is non-refundable.
14. **Interview:** In some cases, you may be called for a visa interview at the South Korean Embassy or consulate.
