## Sri Lanka Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. **Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)**: The quickest and most common visa for short visits (up to 30 days). You apply online.
- 2. **Visa on Arrival**: Less common and availability may vary. This option may involve longer wait times upon arrival.
- 3. Essential Documents (for both ETA and Visa on Arrival)
- 4. **Valid Passport:** Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in Sri Lanka, with at least two blank pages for visa stamps.
- 5. **Completed Visa Application Form:** For ETA, you apply online. For Visa on Arrival, the form is usually provided at the immigration counter.
- 6. **Recent Passport-Sized Photo:** Meeting Sri Lanka's photo specifications.
- 7. **Return Flight Ticket or Onward Ticket:** Proof of your planned departure from Sri Lanka.
- 8. **Proof of Accommodation** Hotel reservations, invitation letter from a Sri Lankan resident, or proof of property ownership.
- 9. **Proof of Financial Means:** Evidence that you can support yourself during your trip (bank statements, etc.). The required amount varies, so check the latest official guidelines.
- 10. **ETA Processing Fee:** Payable online with a credit or debit card.
- 11. **Processing Time:** ETA processing usually takes 2-3 business days. For Visa on Arrival, factor in wait times at the airport. Apply in advance regardless of method.
- 12. Extension of Stay: Possible, but must be done before your existing visa expires.
- 13. **Special Requirements for Minors:** If traveling with children under 12, they are exempt from the ETA fee, but must still have all other documentation.
