

Thailand Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

1. **Valid Passport:** Your passport must have at least 6 months validity remaining from your planned travel dates and have blank pages for the visa and entry/exit stamps.
2. **Completed Visa Application Form:** The form can be downloaded from the website of the Royal Thai Embassy in Islamabad.
3. **Passport-Sized Photograph:** A recent photograph that adheres to Thailand's visa photo standards.
4. **Roundtrip Flight Confirmation:** Proof of your flight bookings into and out of Thailand.
5. **Confirmed Hotel Reservations:** Your accommodation information, such as hotel bookings or any other form of confirmed stay arrangements in Thailand.
6. **Proof of Sufficient Funds:** Bank statements or other financial documents that show you have enough money to support yourself during your trip. The general guideline is around 20,000 Thai Baht per person or 40,000 Thai Baht per family.
7. **Visa Application Fee:** The fee must be paid when submitting your application.
8. **Cover Letter:** Explain the purpose of your trip, planned activities in Thailand, and where you will be staying.
9. **Travel Itinerary:** Outlined details of your planned travel within Thailand.

11. **Processing Time:** Allow ample time for processing. It's recommended to apply at least 15 working days before your intended travel.
12. **Visa Type:** The standard tourist visa for Thailand is a single-entry visa, valid for a stay of up to 60 days.
13. **Interview:** Interviews are usually not required, but there may be occasional instances where you are called for one.
