Uzbekistan Visit/Tourist Visa Requirements for Pakistani Citizens

- 1. Valid Passport: Valid for at least six months beyond your intended stay in Uzbekistan.
- 2. **Visa Application Form:** Completed and signed Uzbekistan visa application form. Obtain it from the Embassy of Uzbekistan in Islamabad or download it from their website.
- 3. Two Photographs: Recent passport-sized photographs with a light background.
- 4. **Invitation Letter:** An original invitation letter from a travel agency or registered legal entity in Uzbekistan, or a notarized letter of invitation from a host in Uzbekistan (family or friend).
- 5. **Travel Medical Insurance:** Valid for the duration of your stay, covering a minimum of €30,000 for medical expenses and repatriation costs.
- 6. **Proof of Accommodation:** Hotel booking confirmation or an official invitation letter stating your place of stay.
- 7. Round-Trip Flight Tickets: Copies of your confirmed flight tickets (round trip).
- 8. **Financial Means:** Proof of sufficient financial resources to cover your stay in Uzbekistan (bank statements, credit card statements etc.).
- 9. **Visa Application Fee:** The fee may vary, so check with the embassy for the current cost.
- 10.**Processing Time:** Processing time can take up to 10 working days, so apply well in advance of your trip.
- 11. **Double Check Requirements:** Always confirm the latest visa requirements with the Embassy of Uzbekistan in Islamabad or their website as they can change.
- 12. Carry Copies: While traveling, carry copies of your visa, passport, and invitation letter.
- 13. Police Clearance Certificate: A recent police clearance certificate from Pakistan.
